Admission Policy

The Admission Policy applies to each applicant; siblings are not automatically accepted.

- I. Applications for new enrollment have priority according to the following:
1. Established Parishioner - with children presently enrolled in this school;
 2. Established Parishioner - without children presently enrolled in this school;
 3. Non-Parishioner - Catholic with children enrolled in this school;
 4. Non-Parishioner - Catholic without children enrolled in this school;
 5. Non-Parishioner - Non-Catholic with children presently enrolled in this school;
 6. Non-Parishioner - Non-Catholic without children enrolled in this school.

An established parishioner is one who is registered in the parish and has been a participating parish member for at least one year. A participating parish member is one who attends Sunday Mass regularly, contributes using envelopes or checks, and participates in the life of the parish.

- II. When space is available, students are tested:
1. To determine the level of their basic skills, and
 2. To ascertain at which grade level they would be most successful.

- III. If a student is found to be deficient in a particular skill area, one or both of the following may be required as a condition of acceptance:
1. Tutoring (Summer and/or during the school year). Follow up will consist of:
 - a. written verification from summer school attendee and/or tutor; and
 - b. retesting
 2. Entering at the appropriate grade level which would accommodate the needs of the child.

IV. If a student has a particular need which cannot be met at St. Patrick School it may be recommended that the child be referred to a school where his/her needs can be met.

V. All new students are accepted on a probationary status for one school semester. This period of time is designed to ensure proper adjustment to school environment and curriculum.
